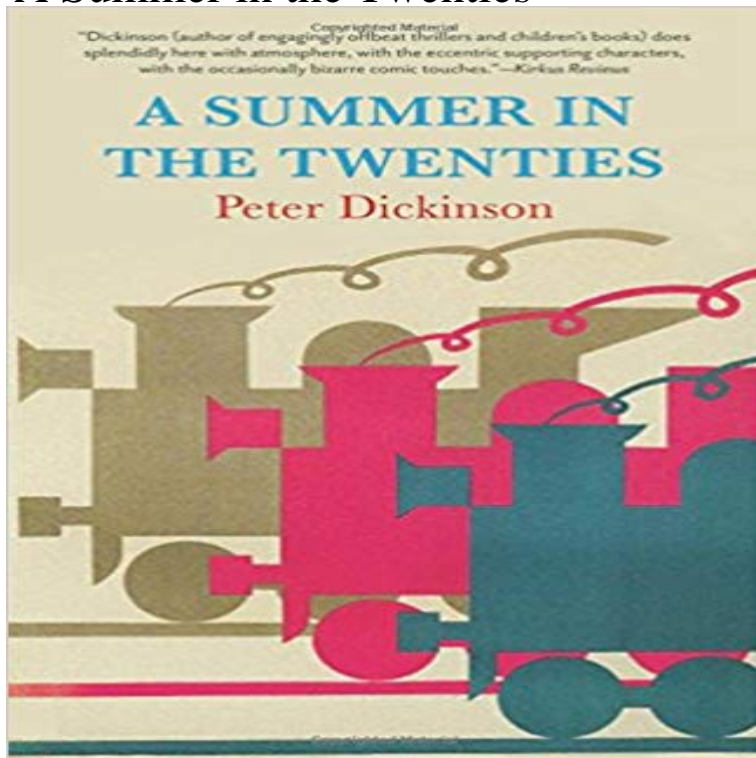


## A Summer in the Twenties
