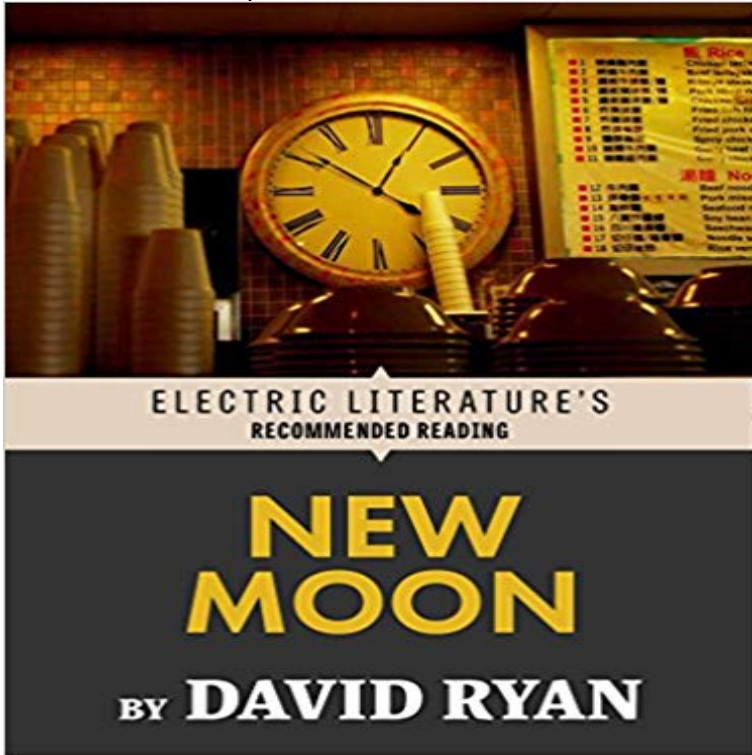


New Moon (Electric Literatures Recommended Reading Book 129)
