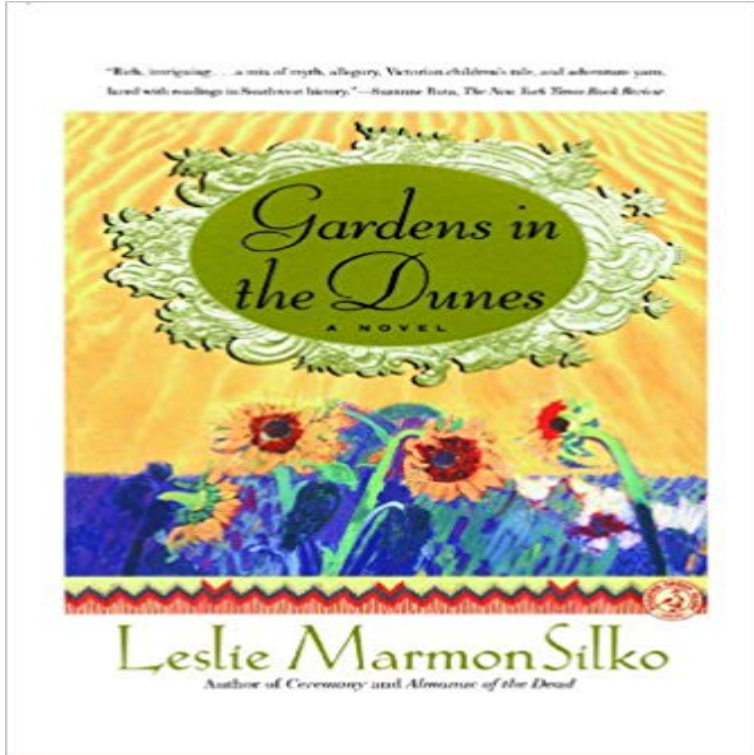


GARDENS IN THE DUNES: A Novel
