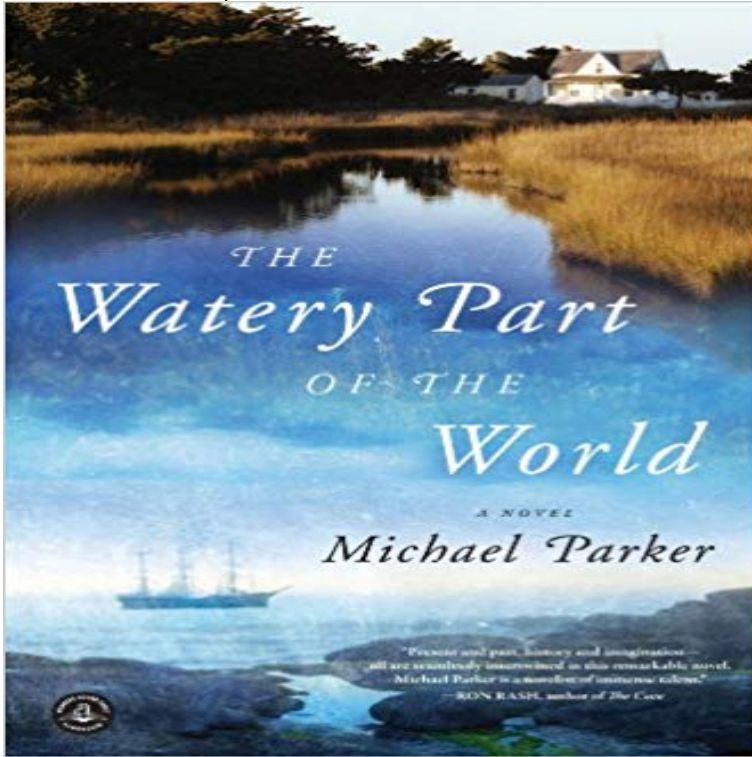


The Watery Part of the World
