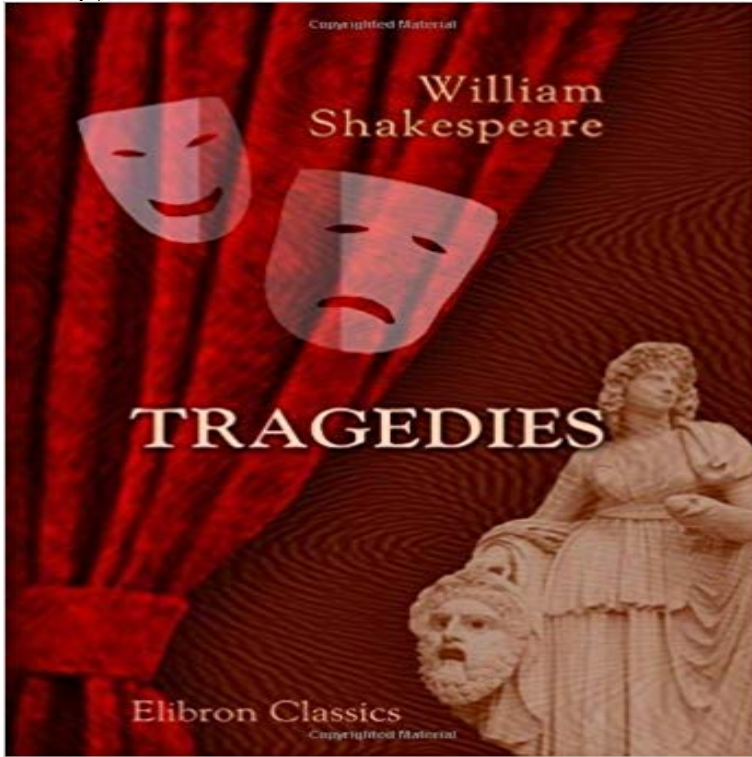


Tragedies



Shakespeare's four greatest tragedies were written in a remarkably short period of time, between 1597 and 1606. Hamlet, Othello, Romeo and Juliet, and King Lear are each so singular an achievement that any rereading of them reinforces the awe and almost idolatrous worship that this most uncanny of the world's great writers invariably inspires. In these four plays, Shakespeare engages the problem that is central to tragedy and crucial to any human community: the problem of violence and revenge on an unprecedented scale. No other literary texts have been more instrumental in deepening our knowledge of ourselves as individuals and as a civilization.
