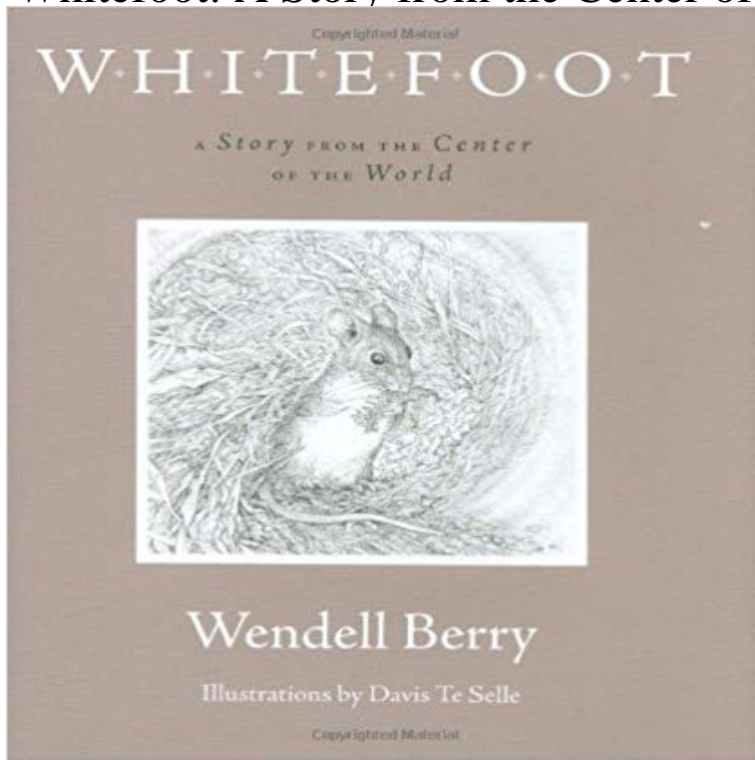


# Whitefoot: A Story from the Center of the World (Port William)
